Know how to play bridge? Want to sharpen your playing skills? This is the course for you! Like any worthwhile activity, bridge requires plenty of practice. The best way to do this is through Supervised Play.

You will play hands in a friendly and warm atmosphere. Hands are dealt at random and analyzed with regard to bidding, play of the hand, and defense. Concepts are introduced in **context** as needed for better comprehension and retention.

Supervised Play is the ideal way to consolidate learning, increase confidence and improve your understanding and expertise.

The Details:

- Each session is two hours.
- Cost: \$5 per session (Oaknoll sessions are free to residents.)
- Class enrollment for Sunday evening sessions is limited to 8 people. Preregistration for each session required.
